How can we help our children to own their choices and their consequences?

- "It's not my fault!"
- "She always gets me in trouble!"
- "He made me late!"
- "I would have finished it, but...
- "I'm tired, so it's okay if I...
- "I can't help it. It's just the way I am."
- "He made me do it!"

Nobody likes being wrong, being judged, or getting called-out when we've made a poor choice. Nobody likes getting in trouble, needing to make amends, or experiencing negative consequences.

In childhood, we acquire an understanding of what's right and wrong and test and use our ability to choose for ourselves. Perhaps Grandma bakes some of our favorite cookies. Maybe she gives us just one and then asks us to wait until after lunch for a second. We can choose to wait and honor her request, or choose to sneak another cookie.

Depending on our choice, different internal and external consequences follow.

One choice to wait and honor grandma's request will lead to strengthening our self-regulating power, as well as our trust in ourselves and in our relationship with our grandma.

The other choice can potentially lead to excuse making, possibly blame, mis-trust, self-justification, and hidden guilt for the rogue cookie. It's just a cookie, but it's the beginning of learning to "own it".

Denying our actions or shifting blame to someone else is a self-defense mechanism that is part of human nature. On occasion, we all do it. These self-protective behaviors always seem to happen when we make a choice that betrays our core values, when we inflate our own needs, breach our integrity, or when we stifle a thought to do a generous act.
