

Model Parent Notification and Opt-Out Form School Climate Survey

The School Climate Survey is an anonymous survey used to assess stakeholder perception of a school environment (see [Utah Code 53G-8-802](#) and [R277-623](#)) and is administered to students and adults.

Students can participate in the survey that aligns with their current grade level. Student survey versions include:

- Kindergarten - 2nd
- 3rd-5th
- 6th-12th

Adults can participate in the survey that aligns with the role of the adult. Adults survey versions include:

- administrator
- faculty and staff
- school resource officer
- parent

A copy of each survey is available for viewing on the [School Safety Center data page](#). The data collected will be reviewed by Local Education Agencies (LEAs) in order to:

- 1) revise policies, practices, and training to reduce harassment and discrimination in each school within the LEA;
- 2) inform plans to promote harassment-free and discrimination-free learning;
- 3) provide insights that can be shared at outreach events to inform students and parents of plans adopted from the review.
