Elective Courses

Elective courses offered Monday-Friday in person. Examples: drawing, painting, pottery, woodworking, foods and nutrition, sewing, piano, graphic design, photography, dance, social dance, jazz, contemporary dance, ballet, choir, musical theatre, technical theatre, and acting.

*Some elective courses may not be offered until second semester of the 2025-2026 school year.

Secondary School Activities

Approximately 2x a month, the secondary school will hold activities. Examples: career exploration, service learning, museums, leadership development, theatre, computer science, coding, etc.

Middle School Frequently Asked Questions

Does my student need to attend the in person electives?

No. In person electives are not required, but you may want to consider checking them out. There is so much to choose from!

Can I still choose to use different curriculum for ELA or math?

Yes. Canyon Grove believes that you know your student best. A school counselor and mentors will help to support parents with these decisions.

Who will teach the live instruction? Our credentialed middle school teachers will teach the in person portion of the hybrid model.

How are curriculum decisions made? All curriculum, both online and in person, is aligned to state standards and assessed through power standards. Individual assessment can be viewed through our internal LMS Boost.

Why is the middle school moving to 2x a week instruction? Canyon Grove wants students to be prepared to take high school courses and graduate. This additional day is focused on instruction that will ease the transition to high school course work.

High School Frequently Asked Questions

Does my student need to attend the in person electives?

No. In person electives are not required, but you may want to consider checking them out. There is so much to choose from! Additionally, high school students need to earn elective credits, but there are options to do this through concurrent enrollment and BYU Independent Study courses.

My student is behind and needs to make up classes in order to graduate. Is this possible? Yes. We are here to help students toward their goals. With our flexible high school model, students can make up credits through competency based curriculum.

What is concurrent enrollment? CE is the option for students to take college classes with our certified teachers. These classes count for both high school and college credit.

Does my student have to attend the activities? No. The secondary school provides these as an opportunity to have additional time to socialize and learn new things.

Is there a way for students to get extra help on classwork? Yes. Tutors are available to help students with coursework.
